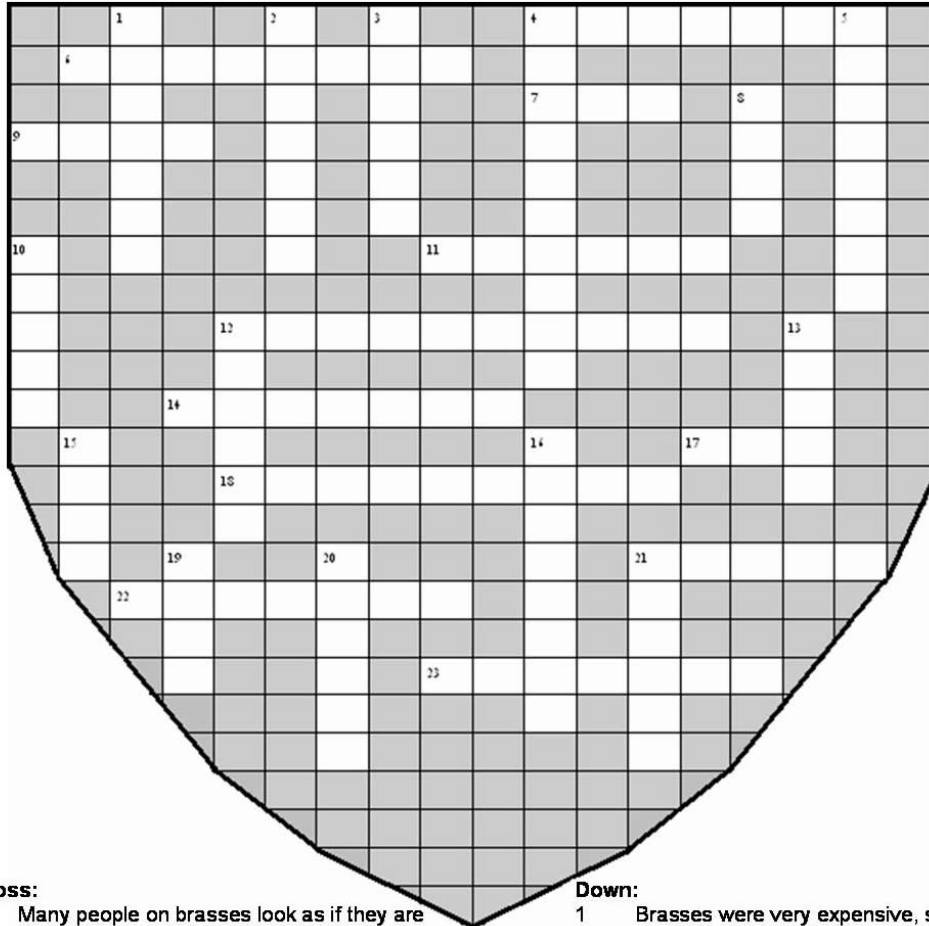


Shield Crossword



Use the clues below to fill in the knight's shield.



Across:

- 4 Many people on brasses look as if they are _____ to God.
- 6 Something made to commemorate (remember) someone or some event.
- 7 An animal, usually beneath the feet of a lady, representing faithfulness.
- 9 A knight on a brass often rested his head on this. He would have worn it into battle and it bore his crest.
- 11 This represents the gateway to heaven.
- 12 A 'heraldic badge' worn by a knight on his shield.
- 14 A linen garment, worn over armour, which protected a knight from sun and rain and was used for identification.
- 17 This was often used to trim the clothes of both men and women.
- 18 The earliest type of armour.
- 21 A knight wore these to encourage his horse to go faster.
- 22 A shirt of mail.
- 23 The name given to children on their parents' brass.

Down:

- 1 Brasses were very expensive, so they only show these kind of people.
- 2 Mythical creature—half lion and half eagle.
- 3 Rather like a short sword, a second weapon carried by a knight.
- 4 The name of a headdress sometimes called a 'dog kennel' headdress.
- 5 The name of metal hand protectors.
- 8 The correct name for a hood of chain mail.
- 10 The type of armour which followed chain mail.
- 12 Memorial brasses are usually found on the floor of this place.
- 13 An early knight would have had to use two hands to wield this weapon.
- 15 An animal representing bravery, usually beneath the feet of a knight.
- 16 A Medieval helmet shaped like a basin.
- 19 A lady with many buttons on her dress would have needed one of these.
- 20 Where people shown on brasses wanted to go.
- 21 A knight carried this to protect himself.
